Description	Article 164 of the Romanian Law on Public Procurement No. 98 foresees that an economic operator must be disqualified from the procurement procedure if there is a conviction rendered by a final court decision for the offence of trafficking in persons and exploitation of vulnerable persons. Likewise, in the standard tender documents, used by the contracting authorities in conducting their procurement procedures, there is a standard form "Statement regarding the non-compliance with the provisions of art. 164", to be completed and signed by participating economic operators.
