

Descripti

The National Action Plan reflects a comprehensive approach to combating human trafficking and includes measures for national and international coordination; prevention; protection of victims; prosecution; evaluation.

The National Action Plan attempts to create the necessary conditions for the Task Force on Combating Human Trafficking – where all relevant ministries, government bodies, the federal provinces, the social partners and specialized Non-Governmental organizations are represented – to combat human trafficking effectively. The National Action Plan 2018-2020 has, among many others, the goal of tackling THB and labour exploitation in supply chains.

Therefore, it contains, for the first time, specific measures to tackle THB and labour exploitation in supply chains. Namely, Action II.22. of the National Action Plan 2018-2020 foresees the measure "Examination of a possible cooperation with existing quality seals (like Fair Trade) to prevent human trafficking in supply chains."
